**OLD BUSINESS:**


1. Ashland Fall Festival

Wade stated vendors are still signing up and we are on track to match last year.

**DISCUSSION:**

1. Mike Fulca reported the aerator in the City Park Pond is still not functioning. He asked Wade to please report this. He also asked for a status on the cracks in the tennis court. Wade stated Coby Morris with the Public Works Department has contacted the company that was used for the last overlay. Wade will report back with an update. Mike Fulca also reported a frequent problem with dog feces on the tennis courts. He stated he wasn't sure if someone brings their dog with them while playing and doesn't remove the waste or if someone kennels their dog in the fence while they are at the Park. The Board discussed some options on how to handle the issue.
