**PARKS & RECREATION BOARD MINUTES**  
**MAY 12, 2014**  
***DRAFT - NOT APPROVED***

Present: Gary Sieckman, Wade Middaugh, Mike Fulca, and Vee Fasciotti.

Chairman Mike Fulca called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Chairman Mike Fulca called for any amendments or additions to the agenda dated 06-09-2014. With none, the agenda is approved.

Chairman Mike Fulca called for amendments or changes to the minutes dated 05-12-2014. With none, he called for a motion to approve the minutes as written. Gary Sieckman made the motion. Vee Fasciotti seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

1. ***2014 Ashland Fall Festival*** - Wade Middaugh presented a budget for the festival with a total cost of \$3930.00. He stated that this cost is down from the budgeted \$7000 of previous years. The City has budgeted \$2,000 of city funds to be used for the festival. The remaining funds will have to be raised by the Parks and Recreation Board. Wade stated that the fund for this currently has \$610 available. The Board discussed the funding of the festival as well as ways to raise funds. The Board also discussed cutting down the number of bands at the festival to save money as well. Vee Fasciotti stated that the Poker Tournament will be raising funds for the festival instead of the Buddy Pack Program this year. Mike Fulca stated that it may save some money to not give cash prizes and instead give trophies. Wade stated he would price trophies.
2. **Visit City Park System (Weather Permitting)** - Gary Sieckman made motion to table this item to the July agenda as it is raining. Wade Middaugh seconded the motion. Motion carried.
